The Highways Officer is still pursuing with the County Highways Department the delivery of signs for the dangerous road by Brougham Hall Bridge. Following the traffic survey on Moor Lane, the request for a speed limit was rejected. The petitioners expressed no further wish to pursue their request. The application to the Highways Department for planting on the land outside Brougham Lodge was withdrawn after consultations with the utilities companies. After further road maintenance outside Pembroke House Farm, the flooding problems were finally resolved during the year by the installation of proper drainage. The damage to a yellow grit bin in the lane to the Castle has been noted and reported.

The Parish Council approved the amendment of its Code of Conduct in line with advice received. No amendment of Standing Orders was needed. Regular internal review of the effectiveness of our internal auditing was held.

District Councillor Henry Sawrey-Cookson attended our 2014 AGM and some of our regular Parish Council Meetings to keep us up to date with County and District matters.
