The poor condition of Pembroke Farm and Farmhouse was pursued with the District Council. The EDC Planning Dept weekly lists of planning applications were circulated to councillors. Electronic Planning Communication has been implemented by EDC.

#### **Other Matters**

To help meet the requirements of the Transparency code, a laptop computer was purchased with grant money. Councillors are being kept informed about the requirements of data protection under the new regulations of GPDR. The Parish Council joined the Cumbria Association of Local Councils for information and support in an increasingly complex job.

Councillors are considering the options for the future organisation of small parish councils including Brougham.

Newsletters and information are regularly circulated from such organisations as the local Police, Community Voluntary Service, Cumbria Action for Sustainability.

District Councillor Henry Sawrey-Cookson attended a number of Parish Council meetings, including the AGM, to keep councillors informed of any relevant local issues at District and County level.
